

## HAM(M)ON(D)(S) VETERANS (218)

### ***Pre-America (1)***

**Francis Hamond (1590-1652)** - "Among the horsemen equipped by George Gawsell and mustered at Swaffham in 1639 to go upon the King's Service in the North". Possibly the Francis Hamond who, with Robert Hamond, John Hamond and three people from the Scarning area, are shown as serving under the Earl of Northumberland in 1640 by the Muster taken after the Army's retreat from Newcastle into Yorkshire. *Is buried in London, England. My 10<sup>th</sup> great grandfather.*

### ***French and Indian War (1754-1763) (1)***

**John Hammon, Jr.** - Military service: 1756, French and Indian War from Lunenburg County, Virginia. *My 6<sup>th</sup> great granduncle.*

### ***Revolutionary War (1775-1783) (5)***

**John Hammon, III** - Military service: 1776, Revolutionary War from Lunenburg County, Virginia. *My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin, 7x removed.*

**Joseph Hammon (1753-1829)** - Martha's (wife) statement was made before the court in Monroe County, Indiana, in 1843, where she applied for her Revolutionary War Widow's Pension. 1777: from Lunenburg County, Virginia Colony. *Is probably buried in Surry County, North Carolina. My half 7<sup>th</sup> great grand uncle.*

**Benjamin Hammons (1756-1835)** - On 5 Feb 1833, Benjamin Hammons appeared before the Wilkes County, North Carolina, Court of P&QS to make his declaration in order to receive a pension for his service in the Revolutionary War. Revolutionary War Pension File W4978; National Archives. On 24 Jan 1839, Sarah MAY HAMMONS, age 70 years, came before the Wilkes County, North Carolina, Court of P&QS and made her declaration in order to receive a Widow's Pension for the Revolutionary War service of her husband, Benjamin HAMMONS. She stated she married Benjamin on 17 Aug 1787 and that he had died 7 Mar 1835 in Wilkes County, North Carolina. (Revolutionary War Pension File W4978; National Archives). *Is probably buried in Wilkes County, North Carolina. My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin 7x removed. Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).*

**James Hammon, II (1758-1803)** - James served in Wilkes County, North Carolina, Militia during Revolutionary War. *Is probably buried in Fayette County, Kentucky. My 6<sup>th</sup> great grand uncle. Son of James Hammon (b: 1730).*

**John Hammon (1760-1868)** - Records of the Veterans' Administration, Revolutionary War pension file of John Hammon, S 9 559 The National Archives, Washington, D.C. He served at the battle of King's Mountain, and was also a defender of Bryan's Station in Kentucky, 1782. At John's passing, he was the next to last living Revolutionary War veteran. *Is buried in Mussel Shoals Cemetery in Owen County, Kentucky. My 5<sup>th</sup> great grandfather. Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).*



## War of 1812 (1812-1815) (5)

**Captain John Hamon, Jr. (1776-1826)** - Military Service (1): 8 Feb 1814 . War of 1812; CPT; Mustered 100 men, 6th Rg. Com.; LTC Henry C. COLEMAN. Military Service (2): 30 Jun 1814; Mustered 2nd time; Co., 5th Rg.; LTC Issac BOOTH; Norfolk's Defense. Reference Number: 2675. On 2 Aug. 1814 Capt. Hamon's Company was in Norfolk during an epidemic of a sickness that caused many deaths. *Is probably buried in Russell County, Virginia.* **My 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin 6x removed.** Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

**William Andrew Hammons (1787-1836)** – served in the 16<sup>th</sup> Company of North Carolina. **My 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin, 6x removed.** *Is possibly buried in Lauderdale County, Alabama.* Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**James Hammon (ca. 1793-?)** – Military Service – War of 1812. *Is probably buried in Owen County, Kentucky.* **My 4<sup>th</sup> great grand uncle.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Lewis Hammon (ca 1782 - 1872)** - Military Service – War of 1812. Served under Captain John Duval, March 29, 1813. *Is buried in the Hammond Cemetery in Orange County, Indiana.* **My 4<sup>th</sup> great grand uncle.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Thomas Hammon (ca. 1795-1830)** - Military Service – War of 1812. *Is probably buried in Owen County, Kentucky.* **My 4<sup>th</sup> great grand uncle.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

- *James, Lewis, and Thomas were brothers.*

## Civil War (1861-1865) (38)

**Joseph Hamon (1841-1928)** – CSA - 1st Georgia Cavalry, Co. G., (application 8 pgs). Pension # 0684 approved. He states he served w/ unknown independent Cav regt, for a year & when it disbanded enlisted w/ 1st GA. (in Clinton, Tennessee). *Is buried in Elizabethtown City Cemetery in Elizabethtown, Hardin County, Kentucky.* **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).





**Franklin Hamon (1844-1886)** – CSA - Military service July 15, 1862, listed as a private: Company C, 7th Regiment, Tennessee Volunteer Infantry. *Is buried in Casement Cemetery in Sedan, Chautauqua County, Kansas.* My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

**Riley Hamon (1832-?)** – CSA - Capt Jackson's Co, Cavalry & Napier's Battalion. Enlistment: December 7, 1862. My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

**Russell Miller Hamon (1842-1906)** - Military service (1): 15 Jul 1862: Enlisted at age 18 as a private. Military service 2: 23 Aug 1863, Mustered. *Is buried in Hunter Cemetery in Huntersville, Clinton County, Kentucky.* My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin 4x removed. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

- **Joseph, Franklin, Riley, and Robert are brothers.**

**Thomas Francis Hammond (1831-1863)** - Fought in the Civil War as a member of the 8th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry, USA, Private, Company E. *Is buried in Cave Hill National Cemetery in Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky.* My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin 5x removed. Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**John Wesley Hammond (1841- ca 1902)** - Military service: 10 Nov 1861, Civil War, Member of the 14th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry, Corporal, company B. *Is buried in Bluegrass Cemetery in Salyersville, Magoffin County, Kentucky.* My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin 5x removed. Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**William Preston Hammond (1842-1913)** - Military service: 10 Nov 1861, Civil War, Member of the 14th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry, 1<sup>st</sup> SGT, Company B. Name is spelled HAMON. *Is buried in Eden Valley Cemetery in Eden Valley, Meeker County, Minnesota.* My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin 5x removed. Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**Jeptha Hammond (1846-1864)** - Fought in the Civil War as a member of the 14th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry, USA. Died from wounds he received during the battle on Kennesaw Mountain in Georgia. *I buried in the National Cemetery, Chattanooga, Hamilton County, Tennessee* Military service: 10 Nov 1861, Civil War. My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin 5x removed. Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**Benjamin Franklin Hammond (1835-1913)** - Military service: 10 Nov 1861, Civil War, Member of the 14th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry. *Is buried in Dr. Will May Cemetery in Salyersville, Magoffin County, Kentucky.* My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin 5x removed. Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

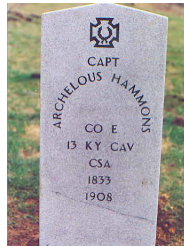
**Hezekiah Hammond (1831-1864)** - Fought in the Civil War as a member of the 14th Kentucky Volunteer Infantry, USA. Died in Richmond, VA, in a POW Camp (of Bronchitis). Hezekiah enlisted with his brothers, Benjamin, John Wesley, Jeptha and William Preston, in the Union regiment forming at Camp Wallace in Louisa, Lawrence County, KY in the fall of 1861. He and his brothers enlisted 10 November 1861. He was a Pvt in Company I, 14th Infantry Regiment 10 Dec 1861. He was captured at Salyersville, Magoffin Co. 30 Nov 1863, one of the five men taken there when his regiment engaged the Confederate forces. The documents from the National Archives support this information, but not the information found at the Andersonville Prison website showing Hezekiah Hamon as a prisoner who was released. It's possible that Hezekiah was slated to be moved to the notorious death camp, but was too ill to be moved when "Ft. Sumpter" opened in early 1864. The roster for Company I shows Hezekiah Harmon listed, however, his widow was granted a pension in 1868 on the basis of the information from the AG's office which details Hezekiah's death in Richmond. *Is buried in an Unmarked Grave in the*

**National Cemetery, Richmond County, Virginia.** Name is spelled HARMON. **My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin 5x removed.** Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**Colonel Jesse Franklin Hammon (1821-1893)** - During the Civil War, Jesse Hammon served as an officer in the State Militia. The activities of Captain Jesse Franklin Hammon, commander of the Thurston Guards, are covered by Stoddard Johnson, Memorial History of Louisville, Volume 1, page 167. **Is buried in Cave Hill Cemetery in Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky.** **My 4<sup>th</sup> great grand uncle.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Captain Archelous Jacob Hammons (1833-1908)** – Military service October 5, 1862 as Captain in Company E, 13<sup>th</sup> Reg. Cavalry, CSA. **Is buried in the Hammons Family Cemetery in Greenbrier County, West Virginia.** **My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).



**Cyrus Randal Hammon (1841-1904)** – Confederate Volunteer. Enlisted in Company E, Kentucky 3rd Cavalry Battalion on 18 Sep 1862. **Is probably buried in Randolph County, Missouri.** **My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Lewis Hammons (abt. 1824- about 1880)** – PVT in Butler's First Cavalry unit. Enlistment: September 2, 1862 in Owenton, Owen County, Kentucky. **Is probably buried in Owen County, Kentucky.** **My 3<sup>rd</sup> great grandfather.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Captain Richard Powell Hammond (1820-1862)** – Company B, 25<sup>th</sup> Arkansas Infantry, CSA. Died at the Battle of Murfreesboro in Tennessee on December 31, 1862. **Is buried in McCulloch-Overall Cemetery in Murfreesboro, Rutherford County, Tennessee.** **My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).



**Calvin Clemmons Hammon (1843-1865)** – PVT, Confederate H-10th, 11th Alabama Cavalry. Died of pneumonia in military prison in Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee. **Is buried in Mount Olivet Cemtery in Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee.** **My Half 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of Joseph Hammon (b: ca. 1753).



**Isaac Hammon (1843-aft 1920)** – Mustered in on March 2, 1865 as Private in Company E, Indiana 144<sup>th</sup> Infantry. *Is buried in Youscreek Cemetery in Orange County, Indiana.* **My 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Hezekiah Hammon (1831-1909)** – PVT Company E Indiana, 153<sup>rd</sup> Infantry, February 11, 1865. Mustered out May 20, 1865. *Is buried in Beech Grove Cemetery in Muncie, Delaware County, Indiana.* **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).



**Ephraim Thomas Hammon (1831-1916)** – PVT CSA, Co. D 9<sup>th</sup> Kentucky Cavalry (grave marker shows 14<sup>th</sup> Kentucky Cavalry), POW – Military Prison, Louisville, Kentucky: Captured December 25, 1863 in Dixon County (state not legible), Pension Roll: M598-89. *Is buried in Hale Cemetery in Mallie, Knott County, Kentucky.* **My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).



**Hiram Hammon (1846-1915)** – PVT Company K, 5<sup>th</sup> West Virginia Infantry. Enlistment: July 24, 1863, Discharge: 1865. *Is probably buried in Lawrence County, Ohio.* **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

**John K. Hammon (1828-1889)** – He joined the 3rd Kentucky Mounted Rifles, CSA, in March 1863. His captain's name was William T. Havens. After the battle of Chickamauga, he was captured by Union forces from Indiana near Shelbyville, TN, on Oct 7, 1863, and sent to Camp Morton near Indianapolis. In March 1865, he "took the oath", and was "galvanized" as a private in Co. C, 6th US Infantry, under Captain David Ezekial. His unit was sent by train to Fort Leavenworth, KS, then marched on foot to Fort Kearney, NT. He was discharged as medically unfit in January 11, 1866 and returned to his home in Owen County, KY. Source; Submitted by Eugene Hammon. Pension: T288-196. *Is buried in Grand Prairie Cemetery in Cairo, Randolph County, Missouri.* **My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).

**Abraham Madison Hammon (1830-1883)** - Abraham served as a Private during the Civil War as of 6 March 1862, recorded at Gladeville, Virginia: Private. *Is buried at Mussel Shoals Baptist Church Cemetery in Owen County, Kentucky. My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin 5x removed. Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).*

- *John K Hammon & Abraham Madison Hammon were brothers.*

**Thomas H Hammon(d) (1832-1917)** – PVT Company I, 189<sup>th</sup> Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry. Enlistment: February 13, 1865, Discharge: September 28, 1865. Pension: 579-112. *Is buried in Woodland Cemetery in Ironton, Lawrence County, Ohio. My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725). Note: The application for his military grave marker shows the name to be THOMAS HAMMOND, but states his birth spelling was HAMMON.*



**Enoch Hammon (1821-1895)** – PVT, Enlistment: September 1, 1863. CSA, 39<sup>th</sup> Regiment, Georgia Infantry. POW, Released January 29<sup>th</sup>, 1864 at Chattanooga by authority of Major General Thomas. #176 on document, listed as 6' tall, grey hair, grey eyes. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)

**Elijah Hammon (1834-1867)** – PVT, CSA, unspecified regiment, Georgia Infantry. POW, Released January 29<sup>th</sup>, 1864 at Chattanooga by authority of Major General Thomas. #177 on document, listed as 5'8" tall, brown hair, blue eyes. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)

**John E Hammon (1825-1912)** – PVT, CSA, unspecified regiment, Georgia Infantry. POW, Released January 29<sup>th</sup>, 1864 at Chattanooga by authority of Major General Thomas. #178 on document, listed as 5'5" tall, brown hair, hazel eyes. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)

- *Enoch, John, & Elijah were brothers.*

**William N Hammond (1833-1901)** – CSA, 52<sup>nd</sup> infantry. Enlistment: 1862. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)

- *Cousin of Enoch, John, & Elijah*

**Daniel Hammon (1834-1893)** – PVT, CSA, 102<sup>nd</sup> Regiment, Company A, 11<sup>th</sup> Georgia Cavalry. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)

**Joseph Lafayette Hammond (1829-1864)** July 1, 1862, 5th Sergeant, 39th Georgia Infantry, Co H Chattooga Tigers. Absent, sick, October 25, 1863. Deserted or taken prisoner of war. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government at Chattanooga, Tennessee and released March 14, 1864. September 13, 1864 - Killed by Gatewood's Raiders, hanged by the Chattooga River close to the family sawmill. The raiders claimed he was a horse thief. The truth was they were a bunch of ruthless vigilantes and targeted him because he'd signed the Oath of Allegiance. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)



**Hiram Gaines Hammond (1828-1896)** Enlisted May 6, 1862, PVT, Company F, Smith's Legion Infantry Regiment, Georgia, CSA. March 18, 1863 promoted to Full Sergeant 2<sup>nd</sup> Class & transferred to Company D, 65<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, Georgia. July 15, 1863 Promoted to Full Sergeant 1<sup>st</sup> Class. November 8, 1864 taken as POW at Coosa Ville, Georgia and taken to Camp Douglas in Illinois on November 10<sup>th</sup>. March 14, 1865, Transferred for exchange at Point Lookout, Maryland. March 22, 1865 placed in General Hospital #9 in Richmond, Virginia. Descendant of William C. Hammond (b: 1777)

**Edmund Dilyhunt Hammons (1837-1910)** – PVT 13th Regiment Tennessee, CSA. **My Half 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin, 6x removed.** **A non-cemetery burial: probably in Woods County, Oklahoma.** Descendant of Joseph Hammon (b: ca. 1753).

**Gordan Hammons (1835-1915)** – Service: April 1, 1862 to September 30, 1863. On April 15, 1905 he applied for Civil War Pension, CSA, State of Virginia. **Is buried in Pearis Cemetery in Pearisburg, Giles County, Virginia.** **My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).

**Alexander M. Hammond (1832-1913)** – 59<sup>th</sup> Indiana Infantry. **Is buried in Hammond Cemetery in Orange County, Indiana (same cemetery as his father, Lewis).** **My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: ca. 1730).

**Ambrose Hammon (1839-1926)** – SGT "F" Company 130<sup>th</sup> Indiana Infantry, March 1, 1864. Mustered out December 21, 1865. **Is buried in Hillcrest Cemtery in Pierceton, Kosciusko County, Indiana.** **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).



**John Wesley Hamon (1844-1919)** – PVT - Co C E 25th Virginia Infantry - CSA. **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** **Is buried in Edwards Cemtery in Wise County, Virginia.** Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).





**Ephraim Wolf Hammon (1841-1907)** – PVT Company K, 5<sup>th</sup> West Virginia Infantry. **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** *Is buried in Fairview Cemetery in Vincennes, Knox County, Indiana.* Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).



**George Washington Hammon (1845-1910)** – PVT Company D, Indiana 65<sup>th</sup> Infantry. Mustered In: August 1, 1862. Mustered Out: September 4, 1864 from Andersonville, GA as POW. **My 4<sup>th</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** *Burial site is currently unknown.* Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

**Aaron F. Hammond (1843-1927)** – Private: Company "D", 18th Kentucky Infantry: 13th Kentucky Cavalry (Union). *Is buried in Hammon Cemetery in Owen County, Kentucky.* **My 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin, 4x removed.** Descendant of James Hammon (b: ca. 1730).

**Special Note:** While not shown as actually enlisting in the military, **James Hammon (1830-1864)**, called "Jim Crow", was almost 7 feet tall and fought a bush-whacking war against the Union troops in Owen County and the Home Guard from Grant County. At one time this "Jim Crow" tried to steal 100 rifles from the camp of sleeping union troops but could not carry all of them and was discovered. In the ensuing fight four or five Union troopers were killed. This was in revenge for the Union Army burning his sister's house. **My 1<sup>st</sup> cousin 5x removed.**

## ***Spanish-American War (1898) (3)***

**William Logan Hammond (1874-1953)** - Military service April 5, 1897 to April 4, 1900, Hospital Corps. Pension #: C-2-521-261. *Is buried in Pineville Cemetery in Pineville, Kentucky.* **My 5<sup>th</sup> cousin, 3x removed.** Descendant of Rev. William Hammon (b: ca. 1713).



**Jasper Newton Hammond (1874-1952)** – US Army, Camp Wheeler *Is buried in Maple Hill Cemetery in Huntsville, Madison County, Alabama.* **My Half 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 5x removed.** Descendant of Joseph Hammon (b: ca. 1753).



**Arley A Hammond (1879-1948)** – Company E 160th Indiana Infantry. **My 5<sup>th</sup> cousin, 3x removed. Is buried in Fairview Cemetery in Bluffton, Wells County, Indiana. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).**

## ***Pilipino-American War (1899-1902) (1)***

**David Hammon (1878-1950)** - Military service January 10, 1899 – September 19, 1905; Private, Company A, 3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry, KY. Pension #: C-2489591 **Is buried in Brown Cemetery in Morehead County, Kentucky. My 5<sup>th</sup> cousin, 3x removed. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).**

## ***World War I (1914-1918) (14)***

**Robert Lafayette Hammons (1895-1985)** - Military service 1: 01 May 1918, US Naval Reserve, Seaman 2nd Class. Military service 2: 30 Sep 1921, Discharge. **Is buried in the Vernon Cemetery in Vernon, Jennings County, Indiana. My grandfather. Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).**

**Titus Jasper Hammons (1894-1960)** – Private, Company C, 80th Infantry. **Is buried in Laurel North Cemetery in Laurel, Franklin County, Indiana. My great grand uncle. Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).**



**Claude Esaw Hamon (1892-1933)** – Private, Company B, 102nd Infantry, Division 26th Mo. **Is buried in G.A.R. Cemetery in Miami, Ottawa County, Oklahoma. My 5<sup>th</sup> cousin 3x removed. Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).**



**John Edward Hamon (1887-1962)** – Private, Army. April 30, 1918 to December 13, 1918. *Is buried in Hayden Cemetery in Hayden, Jennings County, Indiana. My 5<sup>th</sup> cousin 3x removed.* Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

**Sidney Jackson Hammond I (1890-1950)** – Enlistment: April 25, 1918. Discharge: July 20, 1918. Private, 2<sup>nd</sup> Company, Camp Taylor, Kentucky. *Is buried in Beech Grove Cemetery in Muncie, Delaware County, Indiana. My 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, 3x removed (6 different ways!).* Descendant of James Hammon (b: 1730).



**Ira Francis Hammond (1893-1957)** – Promoted to PFC (March 18, 1919), Enlistment: April 1, 1918. Honorable Discharge: July 9, 1919. 158 Depot Brigade on April 16, 1918, Company 10 4 Motor Mechanic Regiment on February 24, 1919, and Repair Unit 328 Motor Transport Corp until discharge. American Expeditionary Forces July 15, 1918 through July 2, 1919. *Is buried in Obetz Cemetery in Obetz, Franklin County, Ohio. My 5<sup>th</sup> cousin 3x removed.* Descendant of Ambrose Hammon (b: ca. 1725).

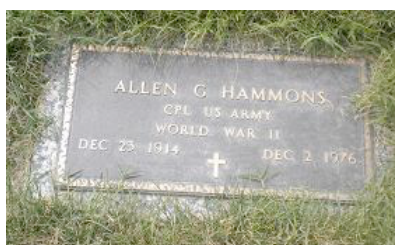
